









Afternoon, visit Thommanon, one of a pair of Hindu temples built during the reign of Suryavarman II, Chau Say Tevada on the South of Thommanon, Ta Keo, a temple-mountain, Ta Prohm, a beautiful temple, bound by massive roots of huge trees. Also visit Banteay Kdei, a citadel of chambers, also known as citadel of monks, is a Buddhist temple in Angkor. The last temple to explore is Sras Srang. Day 3: visit Banteay Srei temple, dedicated to the Hindu and Shiva, the only temple carved in hard pink sandstone in the Angkor region. The next is visisting Banteay Samre temple, worth the extra effort to experience the elaborate architecture, and fine carvings. In the afternoon, enter the world of traditional Khmer handicraft Chantie Ecole-Artisan D'Angkor before your shopping at Old Market then heading to the airport for departure flight back home.

Day 6: boat trip to the Tonle Sap, known as 'The Great Lake', see a number of fishing communities literally float on it. Afternoon visit to the grandest of all ruins, Angkor Wat, then enjoy evening with Khmer performance (aspara show). Laos is also known for its traditional crafts, you will visit local village of Lao ethnic minority groups at Ban Ouay and Ban Thapene drive to the beautiful Khouangsi Waterfall. Continue to Ban Phanom, a well known weaving village, return to the city to transfer to airport, fly to Vientiane. Day 5: full day visit Vientiane, a lovely mix of riverside calm, outstanding temples, fabulous food and charming locals, visiting places: Wat Sisaket, temple of Wat Prakeo, That Luang Stupa, the imposing Patuxay Monument & shopping at Morning Market to buy souvenir from Laos before transfer to airport for your flight to Hanoi.

Day 12: fly Danang to Siem Reap, a little town with a bia, pulsating heart of Cambodia, Free time at leisure, Day 13; full day exploring the Angkor Thom & Angkor Ruins, temples of Ta Prohm, Ta Keo, Chau Saytevada, Thommnoun, Bontey Kdei, Preh Khan, Neak Poan, Sras Srang and Kravann.
